

Dear Friends,

GOOD NEWS! Mission Fever Incorporated is approved as a 501C3 tax exempt organization. This designation is the next step in expanding the scope of this worthwhile cause and I ask you to partner with us.

As many of you know, my passion is leading volunteer mission work teams and blessing the lives of others! Over the years, I've had the privilege of leading 24 mission trips, taking over 320 people to lend helping hands. Here are just three of many remarkable things that have happened:

- Two churches, destroyed by hurricanes, were cleaned, painted and rebuilt, through the hands of volunteers. Both churches are thriving today! A pastor introduced us to his church as "the team that gave us hope."
- One place had outdated medical supplies. We connected them with Project CURE, an organization (with a warehouse in Nashville) that gives away medical surplus. What a joy it was loading the container with over \$300,000 of supplies, including everything on the clinic's wish list! Now, 1,500 people have better health care.
- A college student studying special education with an interest in Down Syndrome helped a mom in Galapagos, Ecuador. The discouraged mother had no special training and her child was developmentally behind. Through a translator the student taught the mom how to help her child. Before long, the girl was in school and reading!

Incredible experiences like these led us to found Mission Fever as a way to *bless others' lives by sharing God's love through meeting needs*. For now, my full-time job as an Air Force chaplain means that all donations received go directly to missions efforts and the operation of this new organization. Our plan from the beginning was to watch it grow over time, and eventually (sooner than later) I want to focus all my efforts on leading this mission.

Since 2009, we've raised over \$55,950 and sponsored five trips, taking 58 people from 10 churches, spanning four denominations. In **Chicago**, we worked in a homeless shelter, a home for the handicapped, tutored at an inner city school; in **Galapagos**, we developed a fitness program for women who never had any fitness instruction, gave music lessons on trumpet, percussion, and ukulele; on the island of **Bimini**, we led a sports camp, led Vacation Bible School, helped start a youth community center, and helped a dear woman by painting her small restaurant. We took seeds and imported hundreds of pound of soils for the agriculture teacher which was a *huge success*. One year later small gardens were everywhere! Of course, we share the Gospel message of Jesus everywhere we go. We are so blessed!

In 2012, we get to touch Europe as International Christian Youthworks has invited me to teach young adults in England and Germany about how to plan and lead mission trips. In summer 2012, we will work at the Bimini All Age School.


